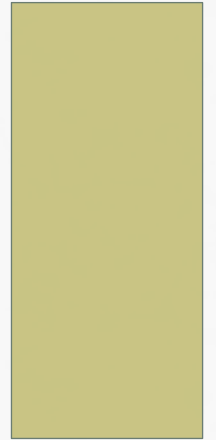

- Membership from all elementary boards and each town within the OSSU district
- First RED Study Committee Meeting June 2011
- First Community Forum September 2011

# WHY DID WE DECIDE TO FORM A RED STUDY COMMITTEE?

- Act 153 requires this discussion
- There are some incentives
- The OSSU Board deemed the RED was worth investigating
- We have an opportunity to be proactive
- Builds on the work we have already accomplished via Policy Governance
- To see if a RED would support our local schools
- To see if we can better achieve our ENDS for students

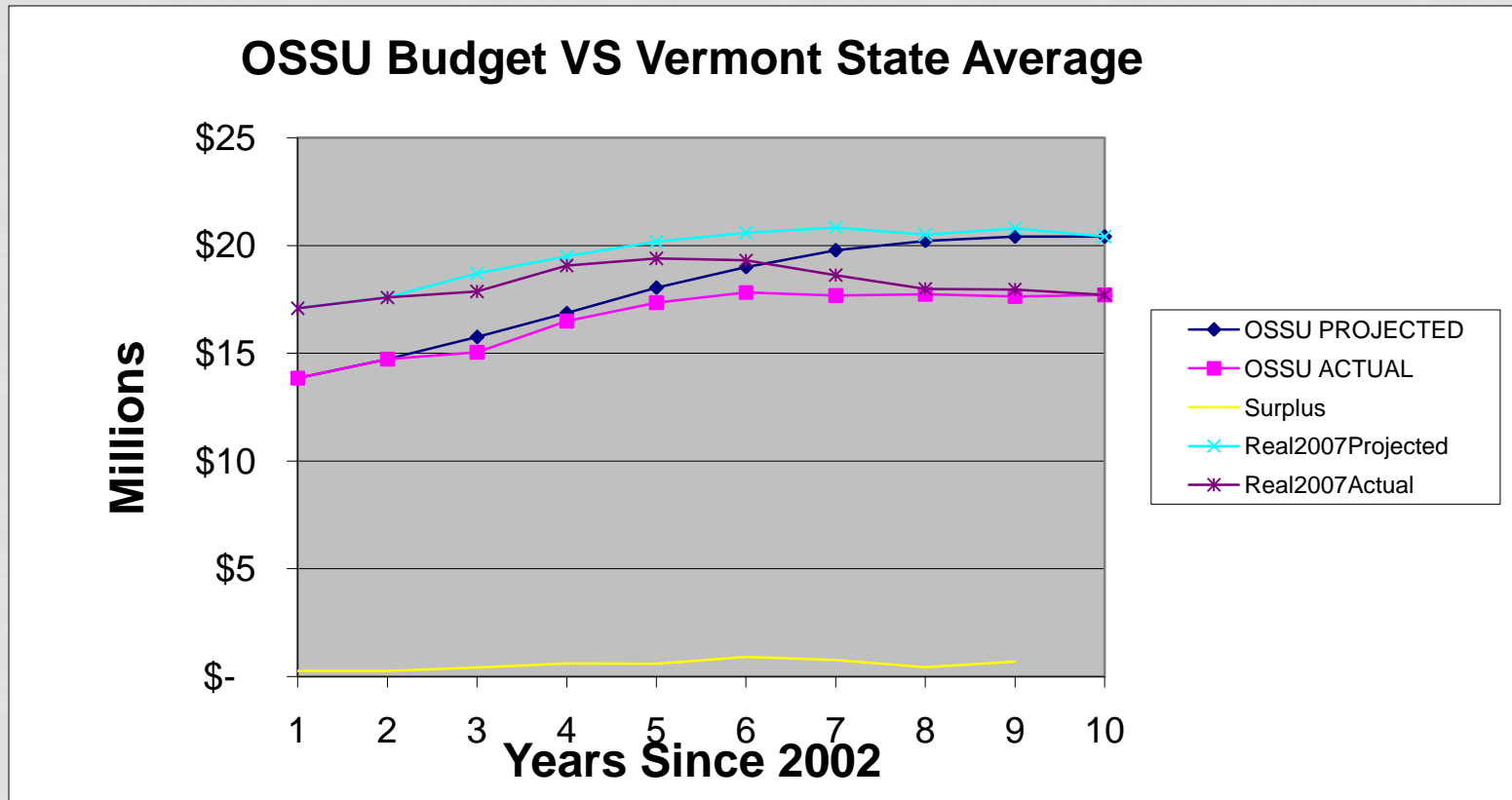
