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### **RTCC Annual Data Report for the 2013 School Year**

This report includes data related to key outcomes of the 2013 graduating class as well as accomplishments of the entire 2013 student cohort.

The following report provides information on the following indicators:

- ✓ 6 month follow-up of the graduating class of 2013 (also described below);
- ✓ Industry-Recognized Certification (IRC) attainment including number and percent of students earning an IRC and total number and type of IRCs earned.
- ✓ Dual enrollment courses taken (including transcribed credit for successful completion of RTCC programs); and
- ✓ Percentage of students who successfully passed end-of-year Technical Skill Assessments.

#### ***Follow-up of 2013 Graduating Class***

The following chart provides a summary of the outcomes last year's RTCC graduates have achieved. As is typical of an RTCC graduating class, the large majority, 96%, are either in college, employed or in military service. Last year (2012), the number of RTCC graduates who are enrolled in college was at 46%. This year's data is unusual in that no students enrolled in a college program *unrelated* to their technical program. This resulted in 24% of students participating in a college program directly related to their technical program. Anecdotally, some of this decrease is attributed to economic factors. Another 66% of students started their careers upon graduation.

### ***State-approved Program Assessments***

Six of our programs participate in state-approved overall program assessments. The assessments are used as evidence of student learning and to provide feedback to program instructors on areas of strength and where to focus additional instruction. It is important to note that RTCC tests 100% of our students whereas some schools only test seniors or other select groups of students. Given this, our test scores are even more impressive. The Automotive Technology assessment is a combination of three assessments. 100% of students passed both “engine service” and “brakes” assessments. Only 18% passed the “tire and suspension” assessment. Significant curricular work was implemented in the 2014 school year on the tire and suspension assessment resulting in a 73% pass rate.

#### **Senior Project completion rate:**

100% of students completed either a junior “tech project” or a senior “tech project.”

#### **Community Service participation rates.**

All students participate in some form of community service within their program. In the 2012-2013 school year RTCC participated in the second school-wide river clean up (from Hurricane Irene). A second school-wide event, “Adopt-a-Family” provides holiday gifts to families in need. Other, program-specific, community service activities are also held.
